#### Food, Nutrition, and Health

As committee chairman this year for Food, Nutrition, and Health, one goal is to provide a "Recipe of the Month" for each monthly club meeting. The focus for the featured recipes is intended to be dishes that are either economical, easy to prepare, nutritious, lower calorie, and the all-important quality of taste! This month's recipe is from the University of Kentucky Cooperative Extension Service 2008. I hope you find it will check all the boxes of focus as this first featured recipe.

#### **Parmesan Chicken**

#### Ingredients:

- -Cooking spray
- -2 tsp. garlic powder
- -1 tsp. onion powder
- -3 tsp. Italian seasoning
- -1/2 cup Parmesan cheese
- -1 ½ lbs. split, boneless, skinless chicken breasts (or strips)

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- 2. 2. Spray a baking sheet with cooking spray.
- 3. 3. Combine garlic powder, onion powder, Italian seasoning & Parmesan on a plate.
- 4. Spray chicken breasts with cooking spray and dip into the cheese mixture to coat both sides.
  - 5. Place chicken on the prepared baking sheet. Spray top of chicken with cooking spray.
    - 6. Bake 30 minutes.
    - 7. If extra browning & crispness is desired, broil for 5 minutes.
