## NOT SURE HOW TO GET STARTED



### What You Need:

- hot glue gun
- headbands
- felt
- an assortment of fake flowers (no stems), leaves, feathers, and any other embellishments you'd like

### STEP 1:

Cut a felt oval and a smaller felt circle for the base. Hot glue the oval to the top side of the headband. Then glue the circle on the underside, being sure to attach it to both the headband and the other piece of felt. Let glue cool.

### STEP 2:

Hot glue feathers, leaves and other embellishments to the base first.

### STEP 3:

Then add flowers, securing them with more glue. Let glue cool.



### HELPFUL TIPS

- Don't underestimate ways to repurpose things you have or can get at Dollar Tree
- Instead of a headband, first glue embellishments together and glue onto a hair comb
